Articles written by members, places visited, web sites found interesting and tips to improve our flying are always welcome by the editor.

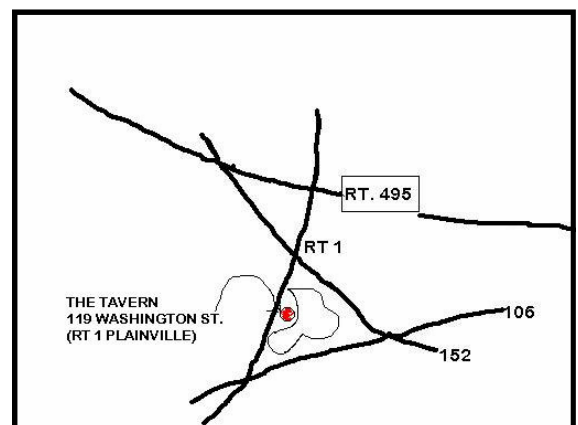
